AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FIRE PREVENTION ORDINANCE NO. 2005-100

WHEREAS, the Elburn & Countryside Fire Protection District, Kane County, Illinois (the “District”) currently maintains paper inspection reports for annual commercial inspections of smoke and heat detectors, fire alarm systems, pre-engineered systems, sprinkler systems and fire pumps; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Trustees (the “Board”) has determined that it is in the best interests of the District to require inspectors of those systems to file their inspection reports on line to allow the District and the respective property owners to have access to the reports; and

WHEREAS, the Board has also determined that it is in the best interests of the District to amend its Fire Prevention Ordinance to require those inspection reports to be filed on line through the IROL system (Inspection Reports Online); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Elburn & Countryside Fire Protection District, Kane County, as follows:

Section One: That the Elburn & Countryside Fire Protection District Fire Prevention Ordinances is hereby amended by adding the following sections to Chapter 9 “Fire Protection Systems” of the 2003 International Fire Code:

901.4.5 Inspection Reports Online. All inspection and maintenance reports shall be forwarded annually to the Elburn & Countryside Fire Protection District using the IROL system (Inspection Reports Online). Any company or agent doing inspection, testing and maintenance to fire protection systems shall be required to register with IROL, as well as buildings that have fire protection systems installed.

901.5.2 Inspection Reports Online. All inspection and maintenance reports shall be forwarded annually to the Elburn & Countryside Fire Protection District using the

IROL system (Inspection Reports Online). Any company or agent doing inspection, testing and maintenance to fire protection systems shall be required to register with IROL, as well as buildings that have fire protection systems installed.

901.6.3 Inspection Reports Online. All inspection and maintenance reports shall be forwarded annually to the Elburn & Countryside Fire Protection District using the IROL system (Inspection Reports Online). Any company or agent doing inspection, testing and maintenance to fire protection systems shall be required to register with IROL, as well as buildings that have fire protection systems installed.

901.9 Inspection Reports. The results of the testing agency or electrical contractors test shall be in writing, signed by the agency or contractor, and kept on file at the premises where the alarm system is being used. A copy of the results shall be forwarded to the District upon completion of the alarm system test using the IROL system (Inspection Reports Online). The test shall not be considered completed until the District receives results thereof. If the results are not received by the District within 60 days after the end of the applicable testing interval, it shall be considered a violation of this Ordinance.

Section Two. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as required by law.

Section Three. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency.

Section Four. That if any part or portion of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
